LAUNDRY

Cornerstone partners with WASH to offer laundry at an affordable rate. Using a smart phone, you can download the PayRange mobile app, register for an account and easily add money. Laundry units are available in each residential hall and are run by the PayRange app.

Cost to wash is \$1.00 per load and \$.75 to dry.

For students who do not have a smart phone available, coin-operated laundry units are available in certain residence halls.
