

International Baccalaureate - Credit by Exam

A student may be awarded college credit on the basis of IB examinations. The amount of credit and level of placement are approved by the Cornerstone Education Policy Committee. IB Higher Learning (HL) exams will be accepted with scores of 5, 6 or 7. Letter grades are not given in any course for which credit is granted. These credits may be used to satisfy degree requirements, but do not apply to the residency requirement and are treated as transfer credit.

- » No charge will be assessed for the processing of IB credits.
- » Students must provide an official IB transcript to the university admissions office at the point admission
